

Term 1 Principal's Report 21 -22 (1st April to 30th September)

Academic year 2021-22 started with online teaching due to the 2nd wave of corona virus with following:-

Book Distribution was done on first four days in the month of April '21.

Covid-19 Vaccination Program @ RES was organized on 03 April and most of the staff members were administered first dose of Covishield.

Academic Year 2021-22 Online Classes started for Grade 6 to 10. For the month of April-May the timings were 8:30 to 12:45, due to the split of few grades into 2 sections and for maximum utilization of the Zoom app for the online sessions from the month of June till mid September timings were modified as 8:15 to 12:15 and from 13th September timings changed to 8:00 to 1:30 as children started coming to the campus. Gr 9 and 10 Offline Schooling started from 26th of July, 2021 and Gr 6 to 8 from 6th September as per the guidelines from the Government. Within a week's time except for very few, all the students started coming to school.

Academic Year 2021-22 Online Classes started for Grade 1 to 5 on 6th of April 2021 and for the months of April-May timings were 8:30 to 12:00, July onwards timings for each class varied for optimal utilization of the Zoom app.

Academic Year 2021-22 Online Classes for Nursery, LKG, UKG started on 8th of April 2021, and timings for the months of April-May was 9:00 to 10:30 and 9:00 to 11:30 LKG and UKG respectively and for Nursery it is 11:00 to 11:30 till date. For Nursery increased the timings from half an hour to 1 and half hour on campus.

As a school, we decided to have doubt solving sessions on Saturdays for all the grades at different time schedule. On week days' regular sessions were taken including the co-curricular sessions too. This year we decided not to cut down on the syllabus for all the grades except for grade 9 and 10. Syllabus for gr 9 and 10 will be as per the board's guidance.

Various strategies used to reach out students are as follows:-

1. Book Corrections: - We earmarked 7 different spots including school as one of the spots for submission and collection of books by the parents. Alternate Friday between 4:00 to 5:00 they had to submit the book at the nearest spot they find from their home and on Sunday between 11:00 to 12:00 collect the books from the same spot. Most of the parents supported us for the same.
2. From the month of July, for various reasons we called students on campus in rotation.
3. Started remedial sessions on campus for those students who were weak.
4. With parents consent, allowed children to come to school and study if they had any issues with online sessions like internet connectivity etc.
5. Begin to call students in the campus once a week in groups of 6 to 7, started calling children to campus, from September made it twice a week for 2 hours. Wherein book correction and all the physical activities and writing practices are conducted.
6. Gr 1 to 3 gave a small study kit for 2 subjects with all the instructions and children had to submit the same within the stipulated time. At the time of submission they had to explain the concept as well as the process of the project made.
7. Gr 4 and 5 were called for Rakhie Making to be sent to the Soldier's of our nation with one academic session of Math and English on campus.

8. Gr 6 to 10 was called in rotation for the experiment sessions on campus by the science mentors.
9. RES students from gr 6 to 10 have enrolled for the science sessions conducted online by the Science center, Dhrol since the month of August.
10. 1 or 2 extra sessions of Math were conducted at the Radhika Classes.
11. Gr 1 to 3 mentors also went for the cluster teaching at different spots in different locations, as part of 'we teach you in your location' initiative for connecting with students.
12. Home visits to those parents who were ready to allow visitors was done as part of bond building and know the well being of the students and parents and for the remaining we connected through video calls.
13. Term 1 Exams were conducted from 23 September '21 to 1st October '21. Grade 6 to 10 students appeared offline and some of the parents from G 1 to 5 opted for attempting from home, others attempted it offline.
